To whom it may concern:

I Johnnie Lane have first hand information concerning, one Benjamin CASTRIGONE in the case indictment 91-1510-001. Now the reason why I have first hand knowlege is because I Johnnie Lane was the driver of the vehicle used in the Kentucky Fried Chicken robbery on, MAIN AND TRANSIT ROAD in the town of CLARENCE at or bout 10:30 pm until about 10:45 pm on the date of August 9th 1991, Furthermore one Benjamin CASTRIGONE WAS NOT one of the four individuals in the vehicle, AND I AM positive of that fact because I WAS in the vehicle myself driving.

On August 9th 1991 I WAS approached by two individuals tuffy summerville AND ERIC Gordon AT my home. AND asked if I would STEAL A vehicle for them. I told them that I already had one STASHED. this WAS about 8:00 pm 8/9/91. I WAS then ask by ERIC Gordon to drive the vehicle AND A few individuals. to A location, at that moment the location WAS unknown to me. I WAS also told that I would be payed for my services. So I Agreed. ERIC Gordon AND tuffy summerville then got into the vehicle AND we proceed to pick up A friend of my's one Derrick BROWN. who Agreed to go with us after speaking ERIC Gordon.

We then proceeded North on MAIN ST AT OR ABOUT 9:30 pm. UNTILL we reached MAIN AND TRANSIT ROAD in the Town of Clarence, where we STOPED AT A Kentucky Fried Chicken restaurant. I parked the vehicle, Tuffy Summerville, ERIC GORDEN AND DERRICK BROWN EXITED the vehicle. AponD EXITING the vehicle ERIC GORDEN put's A mask ON, he ERIC AND DERRICK BROWN entered the KFC restaurant while tuffy summerville waite in the parking lot A the look out MAN. I Johnnie LANE was still sitting in the vehicle while the crime unfolded. Now what seem to be 10 min. ERIC GORDEN AND DERRICK BROWN returned from the KFC restaurant, DERRICK BROWN WAS CARRYING A 22 CA REVOLVER in his hand. they both entered the vehicle, tuffy summerville also returned from the parking lot and entered the vehicle AT which time ERIC removed the MASK he was wearing.

We then proceeded to drive do South on main ST BACK towards Buffalo, AT which time A large sum of money was products from gve ERIC GORDEN in the back seat of the vehicle. the money was then split up AND I WAS drop off AT home.

Now the reason why I'm coming forward with this information is because I've seen this individual, BENJAMIN CASTAIONE, AND AponD seeing his face AND hearing that this man WAS convicted for something I know he did not because I was there, I then contacted one JOHN J CARNEY III ESQ, BENJAMIN CASTAIONE'S ATTORNEY, on the day of _____. Mr. JOHN J, CARNEY III visited me AT the ERNE COUNTY Holding Center on _____ there should be A log, kept, or proof. BUT mr. CARNEY did come AND visit me -

one Johnnie Lane - I then proceeded to give Mr. John S. Carney III ESQ the same information I've just given in this Notarized Statement. I also told Mr. John S. Carney III that I was willing to testify if necessary in court. He meaning Mr. Carney III then stated to me that I would be called to testify. I was never called.

I am still willing to appear in court and testify. I do swear that Benjamin Castricone, was not in the vehicle or at the KFC restaurant on the date of 8/9/91
